- $\Rightarrow$  Begin process of writing job description for Public Works position with Personnel Comm.
- $\Rightarrow$  Park improvements: BB lines painted, mulch in playground next week.

- $\Rightarrow$  Projects: Paint over graffiti on stage, replace electric there (supplies purchased last year), clean up concession bldg (animals upstairs), general watering and weeding.

- ⇒ Fleet St York Water, not told soon enough to get a stormwater system in.May be able to take care of stormwater issues with paving and grading.
- $\Rightarrow$  No parking study. Nine criteria, must meet one. Both met width of road. Ok to do No Parking on both as proposed.

Robin Hyser from EBACC: Weighing three options for new or same bldg. Needs input from council as to the direction to take. Joint Recreation Commission for Intergovernmental Commission to be authority over organization. Capital campaign to move. OR capital campaign for same location with support OR capital campaign with a per capita donation yearly from each municipality. Monday meeting for feasibility study. Asked EB for the title to the bldg for rebuild or tear down but they declined. EB looking to public sell within a year, will not give it to the organization. \$1.8M invested since 1990 to 2015 into bldg, needs over \$1M in the next 10 years. Council comments on various options. Solicitor Shultis comments on his experience over the years with the organization.
